CALL FOR FINANCIAL AID WITHIN THE FRAMEWORK OF THE URV'S DOCTORAL PROGRAM IN "HUMANISTIC STUDIES".

The Academic Committee of the URV's doctoral program in "Humanistic Studies" approves the rules that will govern the granting of financial aid (Modalities A and B) to doctoral students and thesis supervisors of the URV's doctoral program in "Humanistic Studies".

1. Requirements

In order to be able to apply for these grants it is necessary:

- 1.1. To be a doctoral student or thesis director of the URV's doctoral program in "Humanistic Studies".
- 1.2. Present the supporting documentation of the activity for which the aid is requested.

2. Processing of the aid

2.1 Eligible applicants who wish to apply for a grant may obtain the standard application form in the document entitled "Application form for doctoral students" and "Application form for thesis supervisors".

2.2. Applications for the grant, as well as the attached documentation, **must be submitted, according to the standard form, to the General Registry of the URV** (<https://seuelectronica.urv.cat/registre.html>); they must be addressed to the President of the Academic Committee of the Doctoral Program in Humanistic Studies.

Any application that is not processed through this channel will not be accepted.

2.3. There are two deadlines for submitting applications, before May 31 and before November 30.

3. Documentation

Applicants will be required to submit:

1. The completed application form.
2. Original receipts, invoices or tickets for collection.
3. Photocopy of the current account in which you want to receive the deposit, in which the applicant must be the holder or co-holder.
4. Photocopy of the ID of the applicant(s).
5. Photocopy of the current course registration of the applicant(s). In the case of participation in scientific meetings (congresses, colloquia, etc.), applicants must also submit:
 - a. Report of the activities carried out during the congress.
 - b. Program of the congress attended.
 - c. Certificate of attendance.

4. Evaluation of applications

The Academic Committee of the URV's doctoral program in "Humanistic Studies" will evaluate the applications and will award certain amounts to the selected projects according to the funds available and the allocation criteria set out in the conditions of the program.

5. Criteria

The Academic Committee of the Doctoral Program in Humanistic Studies has established the criteria for the distribution of the economic allocation corresponding to the aforementioned doctoral .

It should be noted that only one semester grant will be awarded per doctoral student and professor. However, doctoral students may apply for more than one grant as long as the total amount does not exceed €200 (the specific grant for the printing of the thesis is excluded from this calculation).

It has been agreed to divide the grants into two main groups:

5.1. Grants for doctoral students in the Program

Aid will be granted for the following items:

- Attendance at scientific meetings.
- Completion of on-line courses related to the topic of the thesis.
- Linguistic advising related to the thesis.
- Procurement of special services, such as statistical analysis.
- Reprographic expenses for archives and newspaper libraries.
- Expenses related to the final printing of the doctoral thesis (300€). This grant is only available for will be granted once for each doctoral student who applies for it.

5.2. Grants for professors of the departments linked to the Doctoral Program

- Invited professors to give lectures related to cross-cutting issues of the doctorate (maximum 300€).
- Organization of scientific meetings related to the Doctoral Program and specifically aimed at its doctoral students (300€).

6. Clarifications

The Academic Committee of the URV's Doctoral Program in "Humanistic Studies" is responsible for clarifying any doubts regarding the interpretation of these rules.
